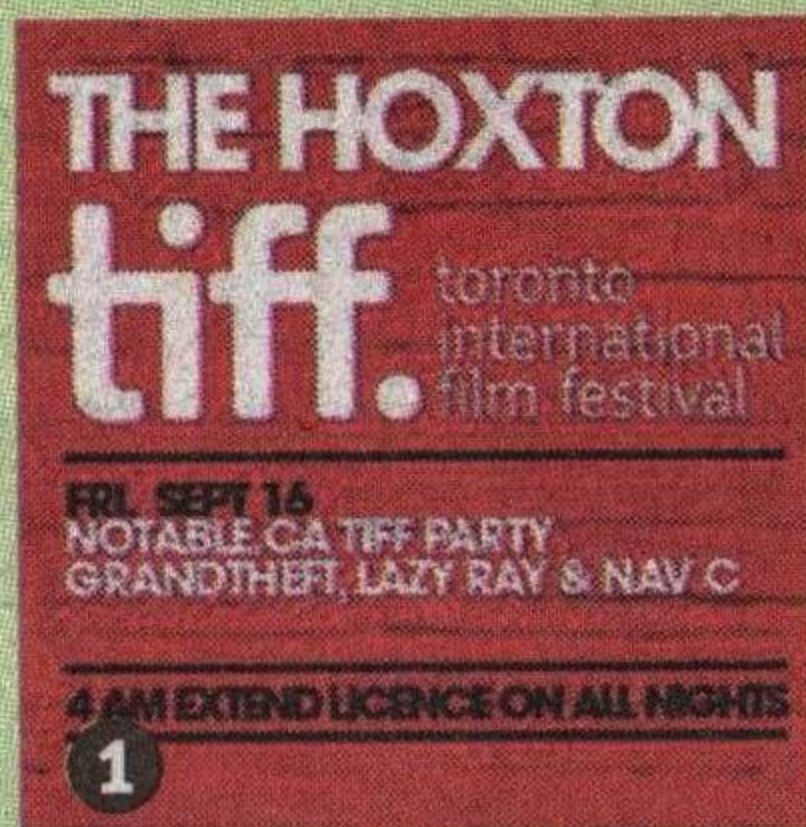

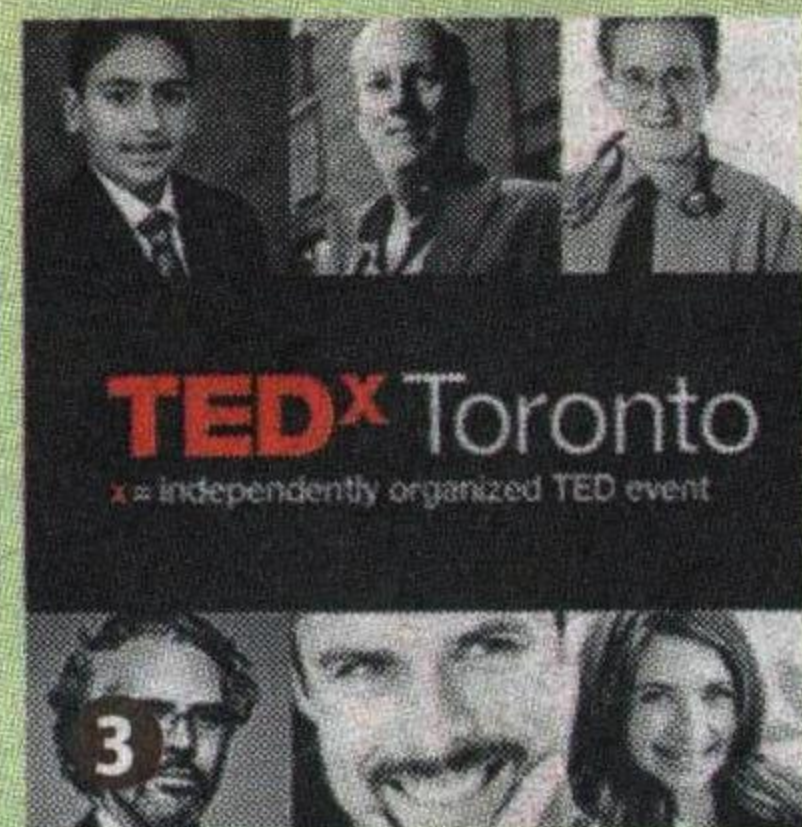

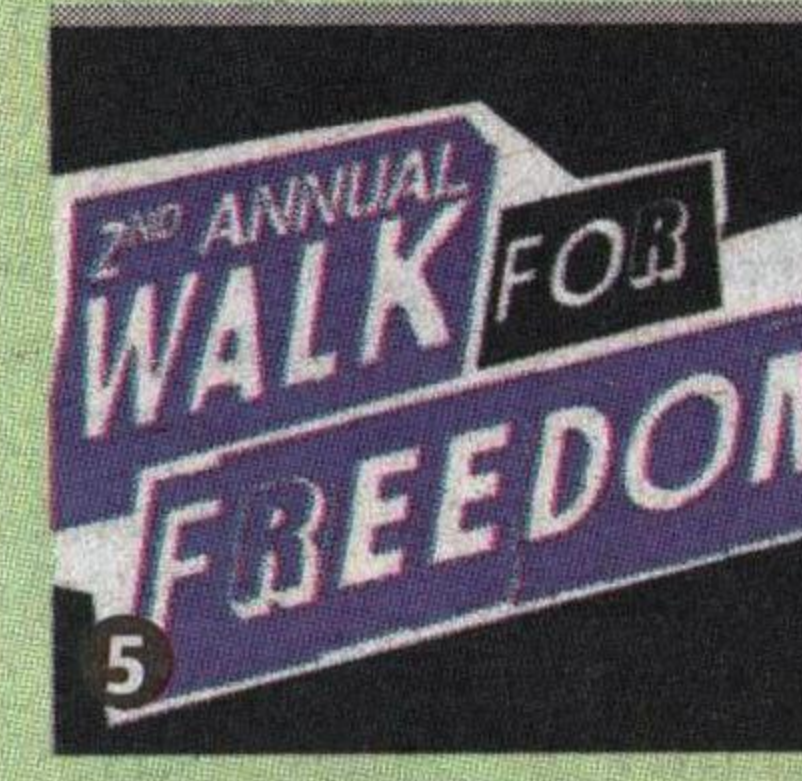
Drake Hotel's Chinatown
